SI. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 12 only. Any further increase in sections shall only be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation by laws and subject to the availability of infrastructure and room size of 500> sqr ft.
2	The school has undertaken to construct the lift to access the upper floor. School is directed to complete the same and upload the compliance on the SARAS portal within 03 months.

3	The Composite science lab is to be upgraded and further developed as per Board's guidelines and SoP dated 04.10.2022 (circular no 11/2022). Seating arrangement is to be increased to accommodate more students. For recommended safety standards measures as per guidelines, permanent and secure gas connection is to be arranged. School is required to follow the board guidelines vide circular no 11/2022 (SoP on labs) to upgrade the Composite science lab and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 month with video link.
4	The School is required to add more books to the library and maintain the accession resister for proper library operations as per the affiliation bye laws and the recommended SoP dated 04.10.2022. School is directed to follow the SoP vide circular no 11/2022 (for recommended infrastructure in Lab, Library and Sports) and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
5	The ramp at the entrance of CwSN toilets is steep ramp with one side handrail which is not as per board guidelines (circular no 05/2023) and the RPwD Act,2016. School is directed to reconstruct the ramp with recommended gradient/slope to make the toilets smoothly accessible by the users on wheelchair. School is directed to make the CwSN toilets as per the guidelines with proper ramp and safety and to upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
6	The Indoor Sports facilities are not as per recommended infrastructure and facilities as per Board guidelines (the circular no . 11/2022). Seating arrangement is made at ground without seating facilities. Only chess and carom are provided for indoor games which need to be upgraded with more indoor sports as per the SoP for sport (circular no 11/2022) dated 04.10.2022. School is directed to make compliance and upload on SARAS portal within 03 months with video link.
7	School has not fixed the school name at main entrance. School is directed to fix the school name with complete address and contact details at the main gate/entrance. The compliance should be uploaded within 03 months on SARAS portal.
8	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers from CoE, Pune and upload the compliance of on SARAS portal within 03 months.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

 The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be

- The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
